Directions to Perth Civitan

6787 Lanark County Road 43

From the East (Ottawa) via Highway 7

- At Perth, first set of traffic lights
- Turn LEFT onto DRUMMOND ST.
- Drive 2 km (through several four way stops)
- Turn LEFT onto CRAIG ST.
- Drive about 1.5 km Craig St. turns into County Road 43
- **CIVITAN** on the **RIGHT**

From the West (Toronto) via Highway 7

- At Perth, last set of traffic lights after Shoppers Drugmart, McDonalds.etc)
- Turn **RIGHT** onto **DRUMMOND ST.**
- Drive 2 km (through several four way stops)
- Turn LEFT onto CRAIG ST.
- Drive about 1.5 km Craig St. turns into County Road 43
- **CIVITAN** on the **RIGHT**

From Smiths Falls via County Road 43

- 17 km from Smiths Falls on County Road 43
- Just before entering the Town of Perth
- **CIVITAN** is on the **LEFT**
