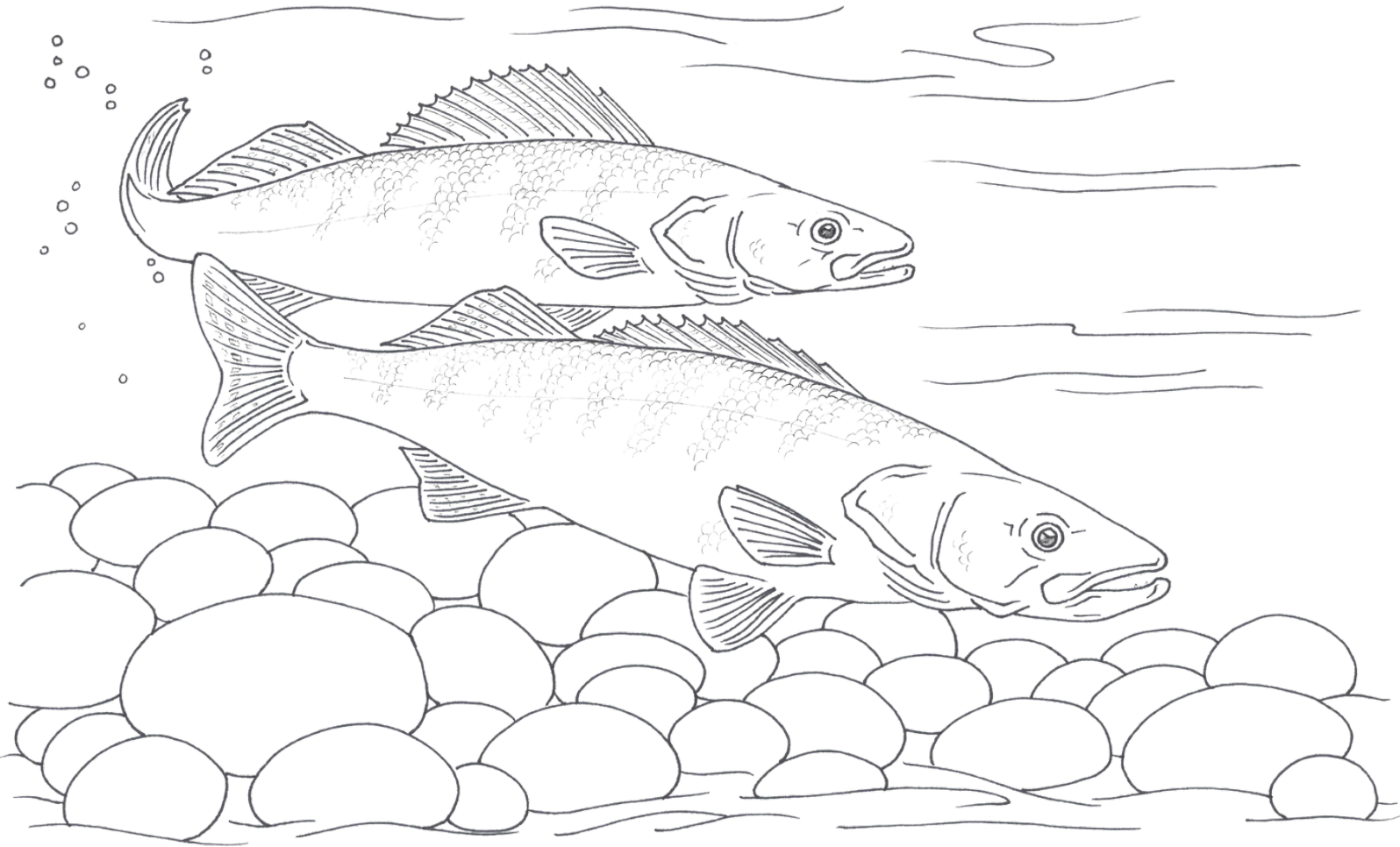

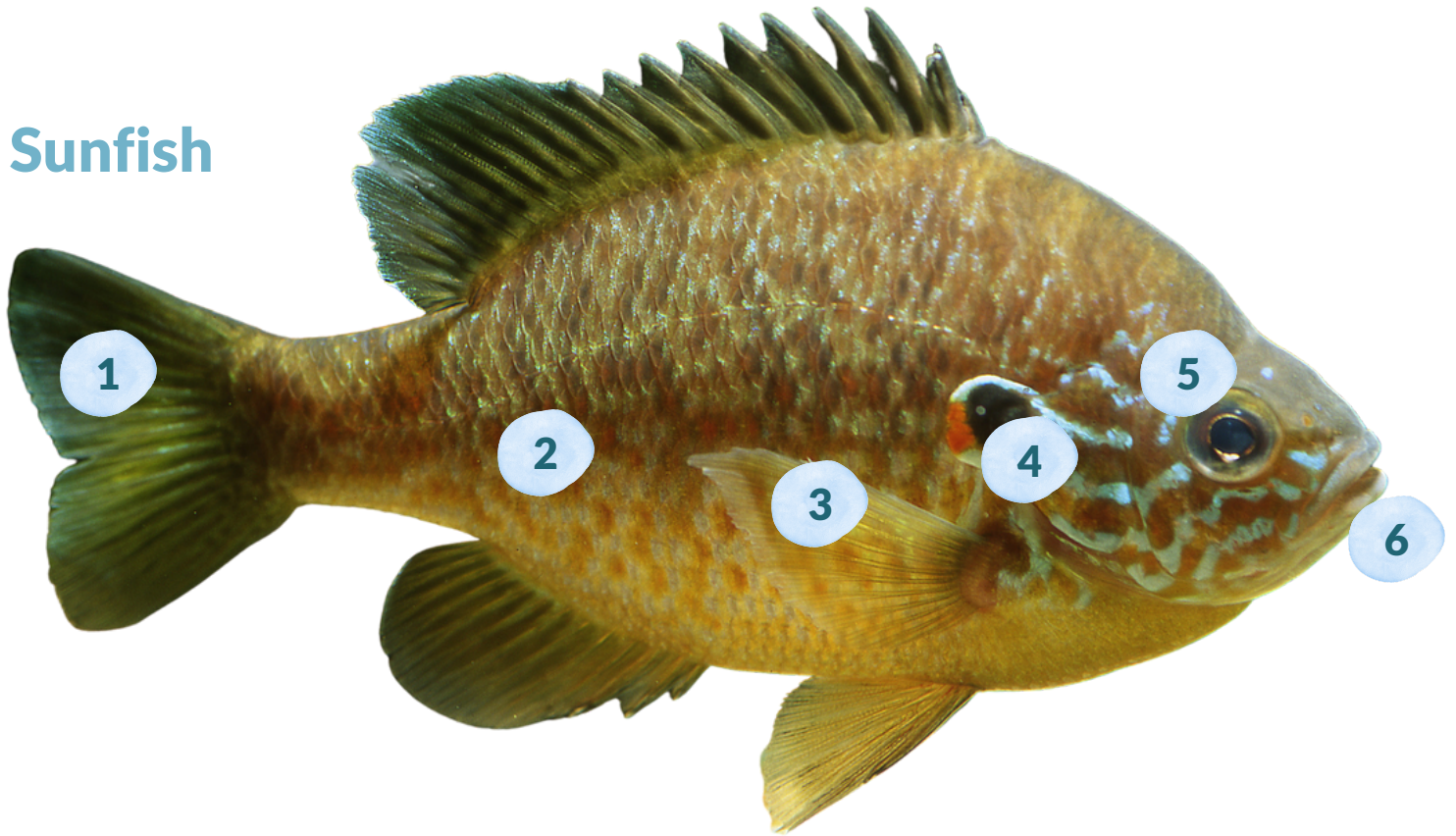

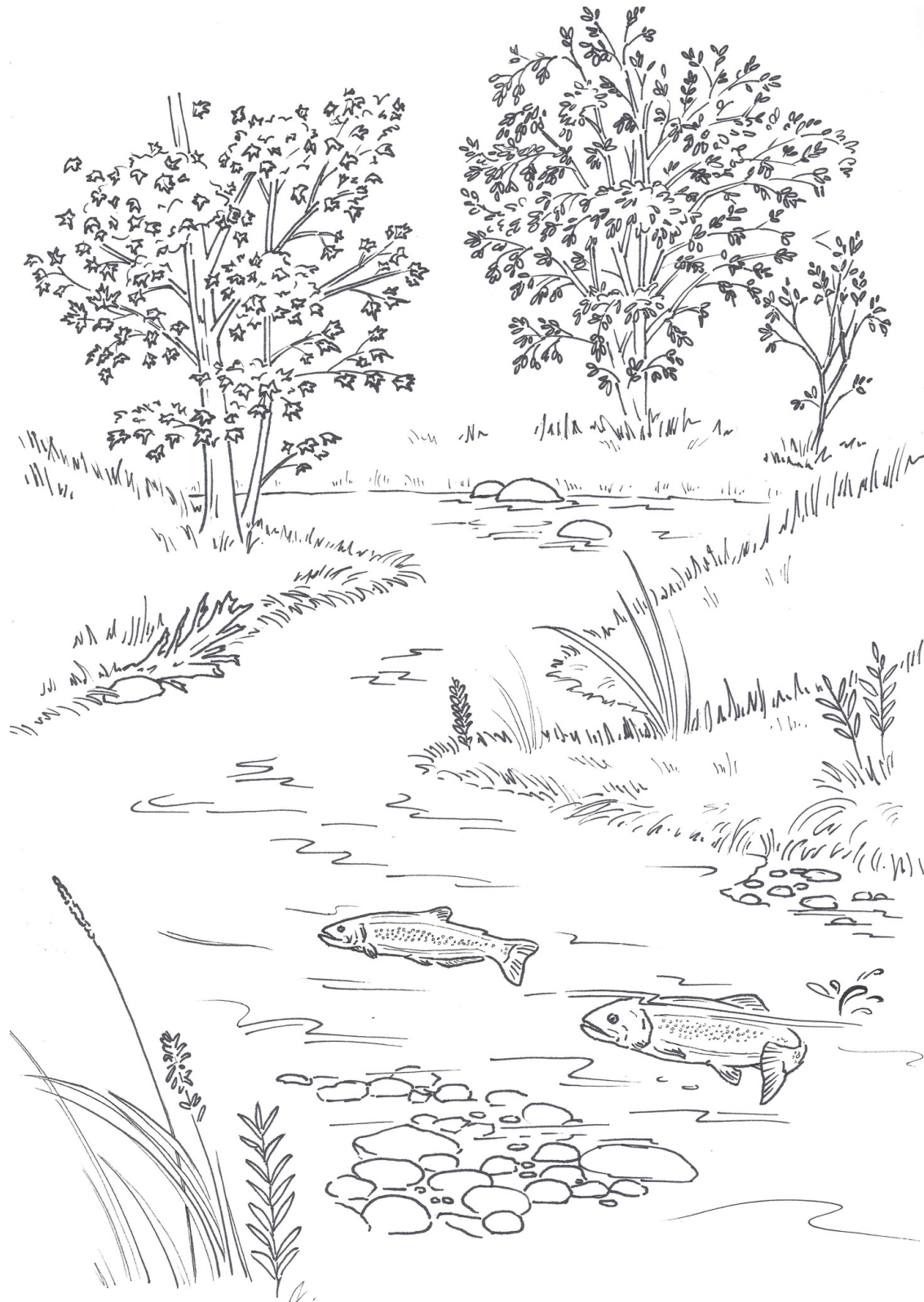

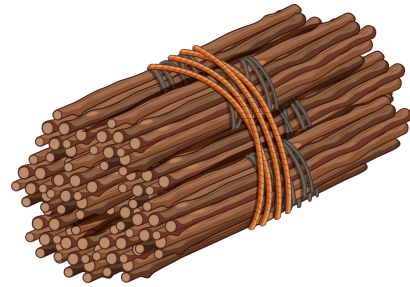
Shade from the trees makes the water colder -

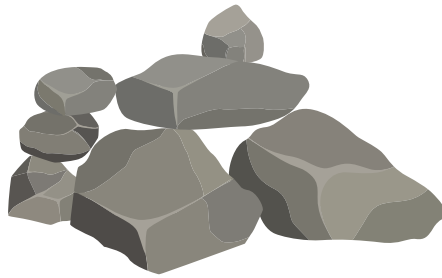

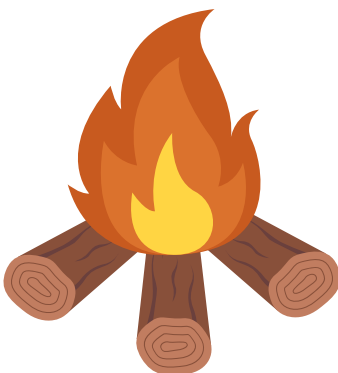

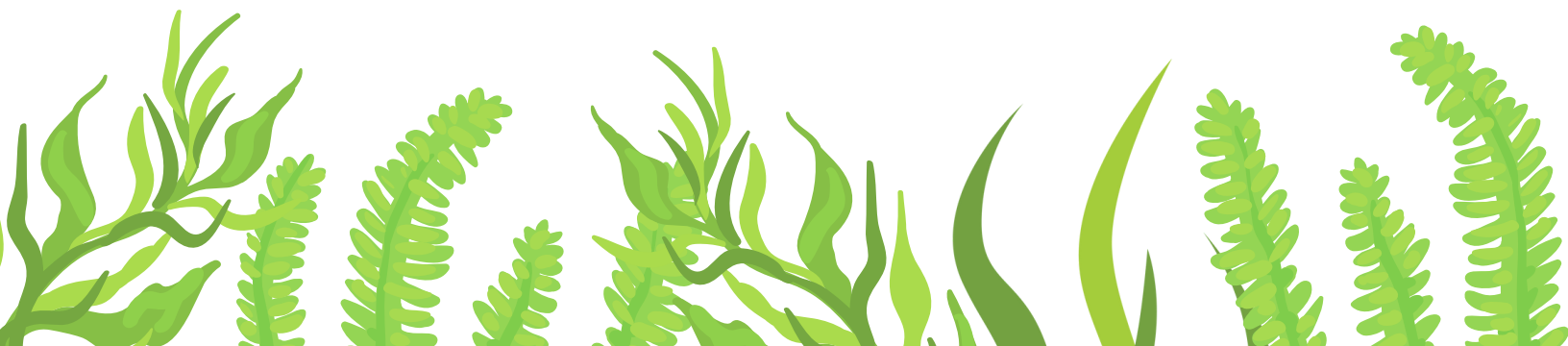

Branches in the water give fish a safe place to eat, lay eggs, rest, and hide

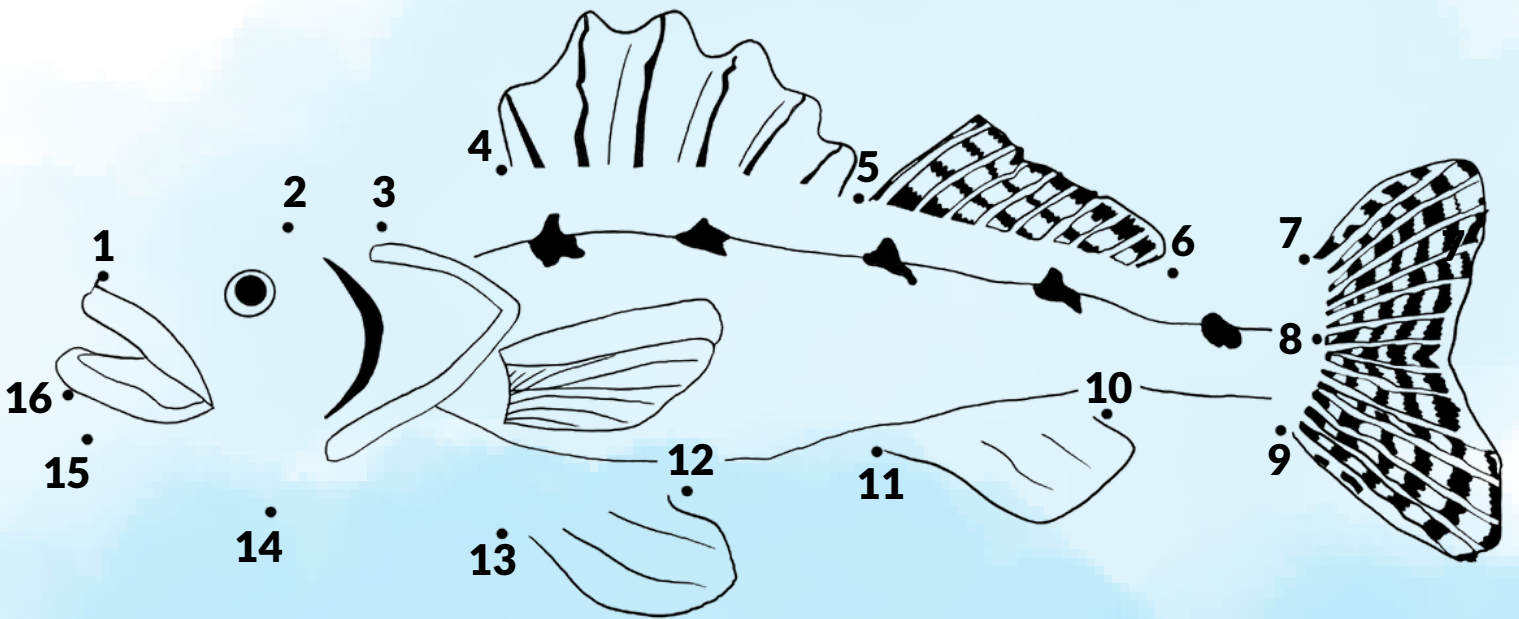
