




Meet Ottawa's fish!

Draw over the line from the fish to their name.




Walleye Riverbed Colouring Page




Stones at the bottom of a lake give Walleye a safe place to lay and hide their eggs




Branches in the water give fish a safe place to eat, lay eggs, rest, and hide




Connect the Dots
